

## Rules of Grow in Glenburn Community Garden

1. The Association shall be called, 'Grow in Glenburn' or GIG
2. Individual members must be aged 16 or over
3. In the case of group membership, there must one named group member who is present when the group is in the garden and who is responsible for ensuring that group rules are followed
4. The site is secured with a combination locked padlock. It is requested that when padlock is opened for access, it is then left in "locked" position while on site for security reasons. Last person to leave site responsible for locking and securing the site
5. Annual membership cost is £15 for full plot and £10 for a raised bed.
6. Times for access to site are:
  - a. April to Sept - 9 am to 9 pm
  - b. Oct to March - 9 am to 4 pm
7. The expectation is that members will change plots over time, however, they may retain the use of a plot from year to year subject to committee approval.
8. All gardening to be of an organic nature, i.e. no chemicals or pesticides etc. to be used
9. No loud music, such that it constitutes an annoyance to other plot holders or nearby residents, allowed
10. Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times. The GIG committee shall not be held responsible for any injuries etc.
11. No dogs or livestock allowed on site
12. No alcohol to be consumed on the site
13. Plots to be kept tidy and in reasonable condition
14. Paths surrounding plots to be kept clear/tidy
15. Members will ensure that no pernicious weeds, including hogweed, Japanese knotweed, ragwort etc. is planted or permitted to grow on site/plot
16. No selling of produce permitted on site
17. No buildings or structures e.g. huts etc allowed on site
18. There will be areas designated as communal by the GIG committee within the site
19. It is required that all plot holders undertake 12 hours communal work per year
20. This communal work to be carried out ideally on the 2<sup>nd</sup> weekend of each month - either on the Saturday or Sunday. A list of dates will be supplied by the committee
21. Any disputes/complaints to be raised with the GIG committee, in the first instance, whose decision will be final
22. The above Rules are indicative and others may be introduced as required and agreed by the GIG committee
23. In the event of serious or persistent breach of the above rules, the Committee reserve the right to exclude an individual or group from the site
24. Grow in Glenburn may collect the name, email, address and/or phone number for the purposes of contacting members and informing them of group events and activities. These details will be held by the committee members and used for the sole purposes of Grow in Glenburn. They will not be distributed to any third-party agencies.
25. Email addresses will be visible in the form of group email correspondence. If you do not wish your email to be visible, please contact a member of the committee before agreeing to the Grow in Glenburn terms and conditions.
